Dear Friends of KYCC,

This past year has been defined by the many historic and unprecedented events that have shaped the world we currently live in. The challenges we've faced over the course of the last year have been an awakening for us all, and has allowed us to reflect on different ways in which KYCC can best stand with our Koreatown community through these times.

KYCC was founded over **45 years** ago as an afterschool program for Korean youth in the community. Over the decades, our agency has grown into an expansive organization that now serves the children and families who make up our multiethnic Koreatown community.

When the pandemic began and our ways of living were forever changed, our agency collaboratively came together to reimagine how we could best serve the needs of our community members. Our community is made up of a primarily immigrant and economically disadvantaged population, both groups that have been disproportionately affected by the economic fallout and global health pandemic.

This year has allowed us to bring our agency together across all programs and expand our community partnerships, in order to provide critical services to those who needed them the most. With the collaborative efforts of our programs and community partners, KYCC launched the **Hot Meals and Grocery Delivery** program on April 6, 2020. Through KYCC ♥KTown, we were able to bring over **13,000 hot meals and groceries** to the elders and medically-compromised in our community.

This year has also immensely impacted many businesses throughout our neighborhood. While many restaurants and small businesses have had to shut down during this time, KYCC's Community Economic Development has been able to provide over **\$300 million in financial assistance** to almost **500 local business owners** in support of the many neighborhood small businesses that make Koreatown special. While our work in response to the COVID-19 pandemic is not over, we look forward to a brighter future where our children and families are healthy and safe once again. Now, more than ever, we are committed to doing all that we can to ensure Koreatown continues to be a safe and beautiful place for our community to live and thrive.

Environmental Services *Green* NEW DEAL

KYCC's Environmental Services joined the City of Los Angeles's Green New Deal, a plan to make our city a more sustainable place to live and fight against climate change.

The Green New Deal pledges to plant 90,000 trees throughout the City of Los Angeles by 2021. The official kickoff of the Green New Deal took place on October 26, 2019 with a Vernon Planting Event hosted by KYCC with the Office of Los Angeles Mayor Eric Garcetti.

In February 2020, KYCC became an **official partner for the 2020 Census** to help count the increasingly diverse and growing populations that make up Los Angeles.

Koreatown contains one of the hardest to count Census tracts in all of Southern California, and consists of a primarily low-income and community-of-color population, both of whom have been traditionally **underrepresented in the Census**. Partnering with various community stakeholders, KYCC planned **outreach and awareness efforts** throughout Koreatown and the greater Los Angeles area to help educate our community on the **importance of being counted**.



COVID-19 EMERGENCY RESPONSE

COVID: HOT MEALS & *Grocery Delivery*

When the COVID-19 pandemic began and businesses began closing their doors, KYCC realized that everyone in our community would be impacted, from neighborhood small businesses to the seniors in our affordable housing buildings. Bringing the agency together across all units, KYCC began its Hot Meals and Grocery Delivery program to support local restaurants by purchasing hot meals to be provided for the elderly and medically-compromised in low income housing units throughout our community.

Jose and his mother Celeste own Paseo Chapin, a Guatemalan restaurant in MacArthur Park, which has been in their family since 1982. When the pandemic hit and they had to close their doors on March 16, they left the restaurant with a sign that read, “We’ll be open in two weeks.” However, months passed and they remained closed, that is until KYCC partnered with them for the Hot Meals Delivery Program.

When Paseo Chapin joined the Hot Meals Delivery Program, they had to overcome the initial hurdle of figuring out how to shift their restaurant to operate more like a catering service. However, after the first meal delivery, when KYCC called to ask if they would like to participate once a week, they “jumped on the opportunity and loved it.” Being part of the Hot Meals Delivery Program, going back to the restaurant, and seeing their staff gave them something to get up for everyday.

For many local residents, Paseo Chapin is more than just a restaurant, it is a space that brings people together, where regular clientele could gather every week and the community can feel at home alongside the comfort of a delicious, home cooked Guatemalan meal.

COVID: KIDS *Town*



In June 2020, KYCC's Kids Town preschool welcomed back its students, teachers, and staff in order to help support essential workforce families in Koreatown. Kids Town re-opened with **reduced-size classrooms, daily temperature checks, and everyone wearing PPE.**


Kids Town also held monthly Drive By and Say Hi events, **servicing 90% of Kids Town families with care packages** including children's activities, coloring and reading books, arts and crafts, school supplies, baby wipes, and more. At these events families could also request groceries, diapers, and other essentials **for free.**

Pivoting to virtual programming, KYCC Youth Services transitioned its programs to **Zoom sessions** for its elementary, middle school, and high school students. With students also having to adapt to remote classrooms and distance learning, Youth Services offered **one-on-one tutoring sessions** for its students as they were adjusting to new ways of learning.

RECOVERY SERVICES


KYCC Recovery Services understood the effects that isolation and quarantine could have on those in our community struggling with substance use. Recovery Service programs were held **virtually** and have been **filled to capacity**, providing essential support for clients through these difficult times.



Substance use disorder counseling sessions **provided telehealth to 1 in 5 clients.**

CLINICAL SERVICES

Since the beginning of the pandemic, KYCC Clinical Services has offered their mental health counseling services **100% online** and have provided more than **1,300 hours of counseling to over 100 clients.**

Since the COVID-19 pandemic began, KYCC's Community Economic Development have been able to help **hundreds of people** with **unemployment, small business, and utility assistance.**

KYCC is also a partner in Free Tax Prep LA, who hosted their first contactless **drive-thru tax event** on June 15, 2020, where VITA volunteers and staff helped community members prepare over **40 tax returns.**



With the ongoing support of The Eisner Foundation, KYCC launched the Koreatown Storytelling Program (KSP), as part of the GenByGen Initiative to grow intergenerational programming. An intergenerational, multilingual, and multiethnic oral history and digital media program, KSP teaches oral history and storytelling to high school students and elders to investigate racial, economic, and health inequities in our community.

The pilot program of KSP began in March 2020, coinciding with the beginning of Safer-at-Home orders in Los Angeles. Consisting of writing, photography, audio interviews, and vlogs, nine youth participants gathered oral histories from 19 community members and elders exploring COVID-19 related issues and adjusting to new ways of life in the midst of a global pandemic.

"When I was younger, my main focus was studying hard in school, getting good grades, because that was what my parents wanted. Now I think that being healthy is the best because if I am unwell, I can't go out and discover the purpose of my existence. I can't meet and communicate with my children, and I can't be the best grandparent that I can be to my grandchildren. When my grandchildren say 'grandpa, grandpa,' I want to be able to respond and say 'I love you' to them. If I am sick, I can't do any of that." - Gilbert

Gilbert K. is an elder resident at Menlo Family Apartments and participant in Koreatown Storytelling Program. He is a father to three children and grandfather to two grandchildren.

"Because of COVID, I imagine that many young people would have been surprised and shocked. I have been thinking that this situation might become a daily routine for them. I hope that they would match their lifestyle according to this situation. Some young people assume that because of their age, they won't get the coronavirus...But they still need to think about their family and their community." - Jong

KYCC's Kids Town Preschool provides high quality early childhood education for 72 children from the ages of 2.5 to 5 years. Prevention Education unit is funded by the County of Los Angeles Department of Public Health. Our goal is to prevent and reduce underage use of alcohol, marijuana, tobacco, and other drugs in the Koreatown, Pico-Union, Westlake, Metro Los Angeles areas, and Culver City and to encourage local community members to advocate for a safe and healthy community. We aim to address issues of retail access and availability of alcohol, marijuana, and tobacco as well as transform the social norms that contribute to underage alcohol, marijuana, and tobacco use.

Our academic support programs supplement school education and foster independent learning through out-of-school-time services for low-income children. Youth development and case management programs provide family support, life skills, leadership experience and enrichment for youth to become active community members. Our programs include the K-12 academic, RISE middle and high school programs, our Summer Day Camp and high school volunteer/leadership programs.

KYCC's Community Economic Development programs and services focus on building community wealth by helping families achieve financial stability. We offer financial education, individual case management, and matched savings accounts to help families increase financial capability and reach their individual goals. KYCC owns 209 low-income housing units at 8 locations, providing affordable housing and social services for the tenants. KYCC's Free Tax Prep Los Angeles campaign educates eligible households about the Earned Income Tax Credit and provides free tax assistance to nearly 13,500 households. Our Small Business Development program provides free technical assistance to small businesses and entrepreneurs to provide economic opportunities in our community. KYCC also offers utility assistance programs to help non-English speakers resolve their billing issues.






