KIM TAE WOO

Kim Tae Woo is the main vocalist of the legendary Korean pop group g.o.d, known for his exceptional vocal ability and emotional delivery. As one of the defining figures in K-POP history, he has garnered widespread love from the public. As a solo artist, he has achieved tremendous success across multiple genres including ballad, R&B, and dance, broadening his musical spectrum. His solo albums consistently rank high on music charts and have earned him a wide fanbase.

ERIC BENET

Eric Benét is a four-time Grammy-nominated R&B artist known for soulful hits like "Spend My Life with You" and "Sometimes I Cry." His music blends emotional depth with smooth vocals, as heard in his recent single "Sunshine." A committed advocate, Benét also supports global education and anti-trafficking efforts through his nonprofit work. With over two decades in music, he continues to captivate audiences with timeless sound and heartfelt performances.

JONNIE PARK

Also known by his stage name Dumbfoundead, Jonnie Park is a Korean American rapper/writer and comedian. He began his career as a battle rapper in Los Angeles and has since become one of the most prominent Asian American voices in the community, from stand up, hosting 'Fun With Dumb' Podcast to his various acting roles, he is a multi-hyphenate artist who continues to bridge the east to the west. He is currently a writer on Beef's season 2 and will be starring in 'Nemesis' in 2026

SUZIE SUH

Suzie Suh is the co-anchor for KCAL News at 8 and 10pm. She's the first Korean American anchor on an English-language primetime newscast in Los Angeles. Suzie first joined KCAL as a Freelance Reporter. Suzie's news career started in Kalispell, Montana where she was a reporter, anchor, producer, photographer, editor & studio camera operator. She also worked in Las Vegas as a reporter, anchor and assignment editor.
