Summary: The Environmental Specialist I (Clean Streets) position is a hands-on position with KYCC's Environmental Services Unit, supporting with Clean Street initiatives. Performance is reviewed on a continuous basis with specific goals and objectives identified throughout the year. Reliability and quality of work will be emphasized, and working with other crew members in a team atmosphere is integral to this position. This is a full-time, non-exempt position working 40 hours per week, between the hours of 6:00 am and 3:30 pm. The schedule may be Tuesday – Saturday, or Sunday – Thursday. **This is a temporary position that is expected to end on October 30, 2026.**

Duties / Responsibilities:

- **Provide professional services for all environmental work by:**
 - Completing all work with attention safety, including using the appropriate safety gear (such as gloves, goggles, etc.).
 - Ensuring all work completed meets satisfactory requirements.
- **Provide professional clean streets services by:**
 - Removing loose litter and weeds from City streets within KYCC's coverage area.
 - Removing bulky items within the public-right-of-way as directed by supervisor and/or assigned corridor.
- **Responsible for completing and submitting paperwork by:**
 - Completing all paperwork pertaining to daily tasks and submitting all paperwork to their supervisor before the end of daily shift.
 - Completing all program related paperwork in accordance with the invoicing policies and procedures established by the supervisor.
 - Following tool and inventory policies and procedures, and submitting accurate data on daily tool and inventory usage.
- **Attend relevant meetings and participate in professional development trainings/workshops.**
 - Attending monthly unit meetings.
 - Attending quarterly staff/agency meetings.
 - Attending professional development trainings, conferences, workshops and seminars in order to maintain and improve professional competence as assigned by the supervisor
- **Perform other duties as assigned by your ES Crew Supervisor and Unit Manager.**



Minimum Requirements / Qualifications (All applicants MUST meet the minimum qualifications):

- High School Diploma or equivalent.
- At least 12-months of paid work experience in construction, tree planting, or related traded.
- Ability to organize and prepare documentation in a timely manner.
- Strong commitment to working with a multicultural community.
- Strong organizational, written and communication skills.
- Ability to work collaboratively with others and a willingness to participate fully in the team process.
- Self-directing and the ability to work independently as required.
- A valid Class C California Driver License, and clean driving record.
- Proof of eligibility to work in the United States.
- Physical requirements: Seeing to inspect written documents; ability to communicate with KYCC staff, clients and public; sitting, standing and walking for extended periods of time; bending, kneeling and reaching to retrieve objects; and dexterity of hands and fingers to operate equipment; and ability to lift up 50 lbs
